Issue

With less representation in our technology and startup scenes, the innovation gap is only furthered.

Less voices in tech means greater barriers to the underrepresented masses.

Opportunity and education isn't universal and is largely untapped, we want more underrepresented youth to be able to explore pathways in technology.


COMMUNITY

Creation thrives on community. We empower the youth to explore tech through **talks and outreaches**, touring the country and working with local champions.

On our **online community**, we continue to engage over 700+ members. Ideating, hosting webinars, offering conference scholarships, internship matching, and linking students to mentors.

Developh Community is powered by a network of partners & scouts in over 80 schools globally, running programs over the year and analyzing their area's needs (state of tech report). Our **Cipher** division works on women in technology empowerment, holding talks, mixers, and mentorship programs.

Our members champion the growth of tech in their own spaces.



EMPOWERING + UPSKILLING

EDUCATION

Developh builds a curriculum centered on inclusive technology and social good to use across our programs; also collaborating with technical partners. We host **workshops** and **events** to show every youth is a creator - and has the capacity to make a difference, today.

We hold events partnered with our Community, along with offering open-source materials centered around technology for social good on our website and repositories.

BUILD, LEARN, EXECUTE

ACCELERATOR

We're firm believers that there's no better time to be a founder than as a student. Developh runs a **by-students**, **for-students accelerator** that helps student explore technology and launch things while in school.

Collab partners with mission-based NGOs to build social initiatives that sustain + scale their work with tech. Teaching students along the way, measuring by direct impact. **Ventures** is for disruptive startup ideas in the technology space; where projects look to get prototyped, validated, and profitable.

Developh provides capital (through grants), mentorship, a network, and a 24/7 community supporting teams - we're like a startup school.

Our process in nurturing student founders.

We equip students with the skills to build a business, and a guided experience to build for what matters.

WE SCOUT & IDENTIFY

We identify talent: starting by exposing students to startups, tech, and social good from different regions of the country.

INCUBATION

Students into building projects are assisted with the capital, mentor network, resources, close technical guidance, and more through our online incubation program.

LAUNCH

We put projects into action, inviting industry leaders, professionals, and even investors to visit our students during Demo Day - a presentation of prototypes/launches.

At this stage, projects should have measurable traction or even results.



We hold a Pitch Day where students can find collaborators and openly dialogue on their ideas; along with working with teams to validate and explore their projects.

We do impact surveys, ecosystem mapping, demo days, and plan to hold conferences to gather makers and share our experiences - they deserve to be heard. Our digital publication, Technology.ph, also uplifts student voices in tech spaces: highlighting youth work, experiences, and more.

Continuously, we build spaces that build student founders and put value into youth innovation.



WHY WE WORK

□ We're a student voice.

Student entrepreneurs are the foundations of a healthy startup ecosystem. (TechCrunch said it!) This first-time founder experience is critical to getting more students to know how to build great companies, and then succeed in the space - especially for minority students.

We're breaking entry barriers and reshaping the scene with more of us learning and building early on.

Developh's active membership is about 70% women/gender minorities; majority in high school/college pursuing STEAM or HUMSS fields

WHY WE WORK

Our ecosystem gives back.

As the Developh Community grows, we have students champion the growth of their own local startup communities: impacting nationally, while building local. We don't just host an event, give a prize, and run off. We invest in people, supporting them throughout the entire journey of learning about tech, to exploring it, to making something happen.

We sustain through our online platform and community; we work to fill in the gaps (intimidation, no resources, discrimination, lack of support system) and work on retention.

WHY WE WORK

Beyond institutions.

Our team was frustrated by the obstacles posed by our educational institutions. That's why we work on intersectoral collaborations, but focus on running things independently - where most students learn best, anyway.

By working online, remotely, and on a global scope: we're capitalizing on growing digital citizens without obstructions. We foster diverse communities and as a result - have more inclusive innovations and results.

It's harder. But it's also more self-sustaining, productive, and engaging in the long-term.



Developh is looking to spread our impact and help launch more products, while connecting people.

This 2019, we're kicking off our accelerator by supporting **10 projects** in collaboration with mission-based organizations. Our Community is also branching out nationally, with regional leadership helping us define and implement programs.
